Day 1: Tuesday 2nd August, 2016

- Depart Newark Liberty International Airport at 10:30 p.m. on Virgin Atlantic flight #2 to London Heathrow International Airport

Day 2: Wednesday 3rd August, 2016

- Arrive in **London** at 10:30 a.m. where our full time Quest Sports Travel Tour Manager meets the group to transfer by private motor coach to the historic town of Windsor - A charming town on the River Thames, Windsor is best known as the home of Queen Elizabeth II's favorite residence and the world's largest inhabited castle, Windsor Castle (entry included)
- Lunch on your own and free time to stroll the old tow - maybe cross the Thames to visit Eton, England's premier private school
- This afternoon transfer to **check in** to a local hotel for a 4 night stay
- Settle in to the hotel then transfer to **practice** with the Match Fit Academy staff
- Dinner at the hotel this evening

Day 3: Thursday 4th August, 2016

- Breakfast at the hotel then transfer for an *introductory tour of London*, including Trafalgar Square, Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament and Westminster. Conclude the tour at Buckingham Palace for the traditional ceremony of the Changing of the Royal Guard
- This afternoon transfer to the tour's **first friendly game** against a local club team
- Return to the hotel for dinner after the game

Day 4: Friday 5th August, 2016

- Return to the training fields after breakfast for morning **practice** with a **professional clinician** from a professional club's Academy / Women's program
- After practice return to central **London** and enjoy free time to further explore the English capital - Maybe take in some of the best views of the city on a cruise on the River Thames or a flight on the London Eye, or simply do a little
- Return to the hotel for dinner this evening

Day 5: Saturday 6th August, 2016

- Transfer after breakfast to the **second friendly game** of the tour against a local club
- This afternoon transfer to Arsenal FC's **Emirates Stadium** to attend the **2016 Emirates Cup**: The annual event features teams from around the world. Today's ticket includes 2 games. 2015 teams were Arsenal, Villareal, Wolfsburg and Lyon
- Return to the hotel for dinner after the game

Day 6: Sunday 7th August, 2016

- After breakfast check out and head north to **Yorkshire** and Coach Raper's alma mata *Leeds Metropolitan University* - tour the facilities including the National Tennis and Gymnastics center, and maybe take the opportunity for a 5v5 tourney
- From Leeds Met transfer to **check in** to a Leeds area hotel for a 2 night stay
- Dinner at the hotel this evening

Day 7: Monday 8th August, 2016

- Breakfast at the hotel then take the short journey north to **York** - Few cities in England are as rich in history as York. There was a Roman York (Hadrian came this way), a Saxon York, a Danish York, a Norman York (William the Conqueror slept here), a medieval York - It is still encircled by its 13th and 14th-century city walls - a Georgian York (much of which remains today), and a Victorian York. Be sure to visit the Minster (cathedral), which makes the city an ecclesiastical center equaled only by Canterbury and the amazing Shambles
- Transfer this afternoon to the **third friendly game** of the tour against a local club team
- Return to the hotel for dinner after the game

Day 8: Tuesday 9th August, 2016

- Check out after breakfast and travel east to **Manchester** en route to **Old Trafford**, for a guided tour of the home of Premier League giants *Manchester United* - Immerse yourself in the history of the world's most famous club; marvel at the magnificent trophy room; test your skills on the interactive exhibits; and enjoy the remarkable atmosphere inside the 'Theatre of Dreams'
- From Old Trafford transfer to **Platt Lane**, former training ground of the world's richest club **Manchester City** and now run in conjunction with *Manchester University*, for **practice** with one of their Academy staff
- After practice travel south into the midlands and **check in** to a local hotel for 2 nights
- Dinner at the hotel this evening

Day 9: Wednesday 10th August, 2016

- After breakfast transfer to visit **Stratford-Upon-Avon**, home of William Shakespeare - take in the Shakespeare House, gardens of Holy Trinity Church and be entertained by street performer's continuing the Bard's tradition
- This afternoon discover the world famous **Cotswolds** - Old English for "God's high open land" the Cotswolds occupy a stretch of grassy limestone hills, deep ravines, and barren plateaus known as wolds, Ancient villages like Stow-on-the-Wold dot the area with thatched cottages and village churches distinctively built of honey-brown Cotswold stone
- Later, transfer to the **fourth friendly game** of the tour against a local club
- Return to the hotel for dinner after the game

Day 10: Thursday 11th August, 2016

- Check out after breakfast and depart for the University city of **Oxford**
- Free time to discover one of the world's great College towns - A walk down the long sweep of The High, one of the most striking streets in England; a mug of local cider in one of the old student pubs; students in traditional gowns whizzing past on rickety bikes; towers and spires rising majestically; a tiny, dusty bookstall where you can pick up a valuable first edition - all that is home of one of the world's greatest universities
- This afternoon transfer to London Heathrow International Airport for the return journey to the United State
- Depart London at 5:10 p.m. on Virgin Atlantic flight #1 to Newark Liberty International Airport, arriving in Newark at 7:55 p.m.
